hour and not exceeding twenty cents in any one week for absence without leave from any such drills."

SEC. 2. Warrants—how drawn. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section one of this act the auditor of state is hereby authorized to draw warrants upon the state treasurer upon the certificate of the

adjutant general approved by the governor.

SEC. 3. In effect. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall be in full force and effect on and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Das Moines Lander, newspapers published in the city of Des Moines, Iowa.

CHAPTER 74.

SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS.

9. F. 121.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-three hundred eighty-two (2382) of the code, relating to the sale of intoxicating liquor.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Solicitation of orders prohibited. That section twenty-three hundred eighty-two (2382) of the code be amended by inserting after the comma following the word "chapter" in the seventh line of said section the words: "Or solicit, take, or accept any order for the purchase, sale, shipment, or delivery of any such liquor, or aid in the delivery and distribution of any intoxicating liquor so ordered or shipped."

SEC. 2. Traveling salesmen. That said section be further amended by adding thereto the words, "provided, that nothing herein shall prohibit traveling salesmen soliciting orders for the purchase, sale, and shipment of intoxicating liquors, from persons legally authorized to sell or dispense the same."

CHAPTER 75.

RELATING TO BONDS OF PHARMACISTS.

S. F. 33.

AN ACT to amend sections two thousand three hundred and ninety (2390), and two thousand three hundred and ninety-three (2393) of the code, relating to bonds of pharmacists.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Bonds to be recorded. That section two thousand three hundred and ninety (2390) of the code be amended as follows: in line twelve (12) between [the words] "approved" and "by" insert the words "and recorded."

SEC. 2. Permit records. That section two thousand three hundred and ninety-three (2893) of the code be amended as follows: in line three (8) strike out the word "bonds." Also in said line between [the words] "papers" and "pertaining" insert the words "except bonds."
