CHAPTER 10.

POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL.

S. F. 274.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and sixty-four (164) and section one hundred and sixty-five (165) of the code, relating to powers and duties of the executive council.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION I. Contracts for lighting, repairing, etc. That section one hundred and sixty-four (164) of the code be, and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "building" in the sixth line thereof, the words "and other buildings belonging to the state situate in the city of Des Moines," and by inserting after the word "grounds" in the sixth line of the same section, the words "connected therewith".

SEC. 2. Purchase of supplies. That section one hundred and sixty-five (165) of the code be, and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "building" in the third line thereof, the words "and other buildings belonging to the state situate in the city of Des Moines," and by inserting after the word "grounds" in the third line of the same section, the words "connected therewith".

CHAPTER 11.

SALE OF STATE FURNITURE AND STORES.

H. F. 437.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred sixty-five (165) of the code, providing for the sale of furniture and stores that are of no further use to the state.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION I. Executive council to sell. That section one hundred sixty-five of the code be amended by adding at the end thereof the following, to-wit: "The executive council shall have authority to sell, exchange or otherwise dispose of any article of furniture, stores or supplies when the same have become, for any reason, unfit for further use by the state."

CHAPTER 12.

ORGANIZATION OF THE SUPREME COURT.

H. F. 728.

AN ACT to amend chapter [one] 1, title [three] 3, of the code, relating to the organization of the supreme court

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION I. Terms of court There shall be three regular terms of the supreme court in each year to be held as follows, to-wit: The first term beginning with the second Tuesday in January, and ending with the first Monday of May; the second beginning with the first Tuesday after the first Monday of May, and ending with the third Monday of September; and the third begin-
