

CHAPTER 265.

TO COMPENSATE N. W. WILLIAMS.

S. F. 191.

AN ACT appropriating the sum of two hundred nine dollars and twelve cents (\$209.12) for the relief of N. W. Williams on account of work done for the state for which he has not been paid.

WHEREAS, A contract was made by the board of trustees of the Iowa school for the deaf, at Council Bluffs, Iowa, on or about the twenty-first day of May, 1896, for the construction of a cistern at the Iowa school for the deaf, the contract price therefor being the sum of five hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$539.00); and

WHEREAS, The said cistern was not accepted by the trustees of said institution; and

WHEREAS, In the year 1907, the said cistern was repaired by the state of Iowa at an expense of three hundred twenty-nine dollars and eighty-two cents (\$329.82) and the said N. W. Williams has not been paid any sum whatever upon said contract; and

WHEREAS, The state of Iowa has been a beneficiary by reason of the services and labor performed and material furnished by the said N. W. Williams in the sum of two hundred nine dollars and twelve cents (\$209.12); therefore, *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. Amount appropriated—auditor to issue warrant. That there is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of two hundred nine dollars and twelve cents (\$209.12) for the purpose of paying N. W. Williams in full for the labor performed and materials furnished in the construction of a cistern upon the grounds of the Iowa school for the deaf, at Council Bluffs, Iowa, during the year 1896. The auditor of state is hereby directed to issue to the said N. W. Williams a warrant for said sum, which shall be in full settlement of all claims that the said N. W. Williams may have or claim to have against the state of Iowa on account of the construction of said cistern.
