

## CHAPTER 20.

## ISSUANCE OF SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPLEMENTS.

H. F. 308.

AN ACT to amend section two hundred twenty-four-i (224-i), supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, relating to the preparation of supplements to the code.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. **Duty of enrolling clerks.** That section two hundred  
2 twenty-four-i (224-i), supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, be  
3 and the same is hereby amended by adding to said section, after the  
4 last word thereof, the following, to wit:

5 "The enrolling clerks of the house and senate shall, in the prepara-  
6 tion of each enrolled bill or resolution, prepare a clear and distinct  
7 carbon copy thereof, and immediately deliver the same to the reporter  
8 of the supreme court."

1 SEC. 2. **Publication clause.** This act, being deemed of immediate  
2 importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-  
3 tion in the Des Moines Register and the Des Moines Capital, news-  
4 papers published in the city of Des Moines, Iowa.

## CHAPTER 21.

## ASSISTANT COUNTY ATTORNEYS.

H. F. 69.

AN ACT to amend section three hundred and three-a supplement of the code, 1913, relating to the appointment of assistant county attorneys and their compensation.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. **Assistant county attorneys—compensation.** That  
2 the law as it appears in section three hundred and three-a (303-a),  
3 supplement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended by  
4 striking out the word "sixty (60)" where it appears in the ninth and  
5 tenth lines thereof and inserting the word "forty-five (45)".
