CHAPTER 20.

ISSUANCE OF SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPLEMENTS.

H. F. 308.

AN ACT to amend section two hundred twenty-four-i (224-i), supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, relating to the preparation of supplements to the code.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Duty of enrolling clerks. That section two hundred twenty-four-i (224-i), supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, be and the same is hereby amended by adding to said section, after the last word thereof, the following, to wit:
- "The enrolling clerks of the house and senate shall, in the preparation of each enrolled bill or resolution, prepare a clear and distinct carbon copy thereof, and immediately deliver the same to the reporter
- 8 of the supreme court."
- SEC. 2. Publication clause. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-1 tion in the Des Moines Register and the Des Moines Capital, newspapers published in the city of Des Moines, Iowa.

CHAPTER 21.

ASSISTANT COUNTY ATTORNEYS.

H. F. 69.

AN ACT to amend section three hundred and three-a supplement of the code, 1913, relating to the appointment of assistant county attorneys and their compensation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Assistant county attorneys—compensation. That the law as it appears in section three hundred and three-a (303-a),
- supplement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the word "sixty (60)" where it appears in the ninth and
- tenth lines thereof and inserting the word "forty-five (45)".
