WHEREAS, a deed was executed, which deed was on the 11th day of August, 1914, duly filed for record and recorded at page two hundred forty-one (241) of book six hundred forty-seven (647) of the records of the office of the county recorder of Polk county, Iowa, and

WHEREAS, through oversight and mistake of the scrivener drawing said deed, the state of Iowa was named therein as grantee, and

WHEREAS, the state of Iowa never had or claimed any right, title or interest in or to said real estate, now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. Quit claim deed authorized. That the governor of
- 2 the state and the secretary of state are hereby authorized to execute
- 3 and deliver unto the said Eliza J. Lyon quit claim deed conveying all
- 4 the right, title and interest of the state of Iowa in and to said real
- 5 estate.

CHAPTER 160.

OF THE SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF.

H. F. 332.

AN ACT transferring control of state school for the deaf from state board of control to the state board of education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. Management of School for the Deaf. All the powers
- 2 heretofore granted to and exercised by the board of control over the
- 3 state school for the deaf are hereby transferred to the state board of
- 4 education, and the state board of education is hereby authorized and
- 5 empowered to take charge of, manage and control such school for the
- 6 deaf.

- 1 SEC. 2. Transfer of funds. All funds now in the hands of the
- 2 treasurer of state to the credit of said school for the deaf are trans-
- 3 ferred from the board of control to the state board of education.
