

5 election of said school district, held on January 9th, 1917, at which elec-
 6 tion the question was submitted and voted upon of the issuance of
 7 school building bonds in the sum of twelve thousand (\$12,000) dollars
 8 for the purpose of completing and equipping the school house built
 9 by said school district pursuant to the special election held on August
 10 5th, 1915, at which time a bond issue of forty-three thousand
 11 (\$43,000) dollars was authorized by the voters of said district, in-
 12 cluding the publication of the notice of election, be and the same are
 13 hereby legalized.

1 **SEC. 2. Pending litigation.** Nothing herein contained shall be
 2 construed to affect any pending litigation.

1 **SEC. 3. Publication clause.** This act being deemed of immediate
 2 importance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its
 3 publication in the Des Moines Register, a newspaper published in
 4 Des Moines, Iowa, and the Waterloo Evening Courier and Reporter,
 5 a newspaper published in Waterloo, Iowa, without expense to the
 6 state.

CHAPTER 244.

MUNICIPAL BONDS FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS.

S. F. 562.

AN ACT to amend section eight hundred forty-two (842) of the code relating to the
 issuing of bonds for the payment of the assessed cost of street improvements.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 **SECTION 1. Bonds.** That section eight hundred forty-two of the
 2 code be, and the same is hereby amended as follows: By striking
 3 out of the third line of said section the words "abutting thereon"
 4 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "subject to assessment there-
 5 for."
