CHAPTER 29

FISH AND GAME

S. F. 506

AN ACT to amend section two thousand five hundred fifty-one (2551) supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, (S. C. C. 1124), as amended by chapter two hundred thirty-three (233), acts of the thirty-seventh general assembly and chapter thirty-three (33), acts of the thirty-ninth general assembly, relating to the protection of ruffed grouse or pheasant.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Ruffed grouse or pheasant. That section two thousand five hundred fifty-one (2551), supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, (S. C. C. 1124), as amended by chapter two hundred thirty-three (233), acts of the thirty-seventh general assembly and chapter thirty-three (33), acts of the thirty-ninth general assembly, be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the period (.) after the word "seven" in line five (5) of section one (1) of chapter thirty-three (33), acts of the thirty-ninth general assembly, and substituting in lieu thereof a semi-colon (;) and adding thereafter the words "or any ruffed grouse or pheasant prior to November first, nineteen hundred thirty-two."

CHAPTER 30

FISH AND GAME

S. F. 414

AN ACT to amend section two thousand five hundred fifty-one (2551) supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, (S. C. C. 1124), relating to the use of artificial ambushes.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Ambushes. That section two thousand five hundred fifty-one (2551), supplemental supplement to the code, 1915, (S. C. C. 1124), be and the same is hereby amended by striking out from between the words "section" and "with" in line sixteen (16) thereof the words "from any artificial ambush of any kind or", and by striking out from line nineteen (19) thereof the words "or other device used for concealment in the open water," following the comma after the word "paddle", and by striking out from between the words "any" and "sink" in line twenty-eight (28) thereof the word "ambush".
