CHAPTER 133

SOLDIERS' RELIEF COMMISSION

S. F. 308

AN ACT to amend section fifty-three hundred eighty-seven (5387) of the code, relating to the membership of the soldiers' relief commission.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section fifty-three hundred eighty-seven (5387) of the code is amended by striking from line three (3) the word "two" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "all".
- 1 SEC. 2. Section fifty-three hundred eighty-seven (5387) of the 2 code is farther amended by adding thereto the following, to wit:
- 3 "Said membership shall at all times, as near as possible, be equally 4 divided between the soldiers, sailors, marines, and nurses of the civil

5 war, Spanish-American war, and world war."

CHAPTER 134

SOLDIERS' RELIEF COMMISSION

H. F. 257

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred seventy-three (273) of the code, 1924, relating to the relief commission for soldiers, sailors, and marines, and to provide compensation for their services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred seventy-three (273) of the code, 1924, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following as section
- 3 fifty-three hundred eighty-eight b-one (5388-b1):
- 5388-b1. The members of said commission shall be paid for their services the sum of two dollars (\$2.00) per day for each day actually employed in the work of said commission, and also the same mileage
- 7 that is paid to the members of the board of supervisors. Said per
- 8 diem and mileage shall be paid out of the taxes raised under the
- 9 provisions of section fifty-three hundred eighty-five (5385) of the
- 10 code.
