CHAPTER 196

INSURANCE—DEPUTY COMMISSIONER

S. F. 208

AN ACT to repeal section eighty-six hundred eight (8608) of the code of 1924 relating to a deputy commissioner of insurance and to enact a substitute in lieu thereof.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. That the law as it appears in section eighty-six hundred eight (8608) of the code of 1924 be, and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:
- The commissioner of insurance shall appoint a first and second deputy commissioner and such other clerks and assistants as shall
- 6 be needed to assist him in the performance of his duty, all of whom
- 7 shall serve during the pleasure of the commissioner. Before entering
- 8 upon the duties of their respective offices, deputy commissioners shall
- give a bond in the penal sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00).
