- in full force and effect after its publication in Plain Talk, and Altoona
- Herald, newspapers published in Polk county, Iowa, without expense 3

to the state.

CHAPTER 9

RENEWALS OF CHARTERS

AN ACT to amend section ten thousand four hundred ten (10410) of the code, 1927, relating to renewals of charters for private corporations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section ten thousand four hundred ten (10410) of the code, 1927, is amended by striking out of line two (2) the words
- and figures "taken prior to July 1, 1927" and inserting in lieu thereof
 - "or is taken prior to July 1, 1929".

- in force from and after its publication in the Iowa Legionaire, a news-
- paper published in Des Moines, Iowa, and the Daily Times, a newspaper published in Davenport, Iowa.
