

1 SEC. 87-a. Should any court of competent jurisdiction within the  
 2 state of Iowa declare any of the provisions of this act unconstitutional,  
 3 illegal, or void, such decision shall not invalidate any other provision  
 4 herein contained.

1 SEC. 88. Sections forty-six hundred thirty-five (4635) to forty-six  
 2 hundred forty-four (4644), inclusive, sections forty-six hundred forty-  
 3 six (4646), to forty-six hundred fifty (4650), inclusive, forty-six hun-  
 4 dred sixty-two-a two (4662-a2), forty-six hundred sixty-four (4664),  
 5 forty-six hundred sixty-five (4665), forty-six hundred seventy-five  
 6 (4675), seventy-four hundred eighty-five (7485), and chapters two  
 7 hundred forty-four (244) and two hundred forty-five (245), code,  
 8 1927, are repealed.

## CHAPTER 21

### PRIMARY ROADS. ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE

AN ACT to amend section forty-seven hundred fifty-five-b-twenty-seven (4755-b27) of the code, 1927, relating to the improvement, maintenance, relocation or establishment of primary roads, the purchase or condemnation of right of way therefor and the filing of right of way maps.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. That section forty-seven hundred fifty-five-b-twenty-  
 2 seven (4755-b27) of the code, 1927, is hereby amended:  
 3 a. By inserting the words "maintenance, relocation, establish-  
 4 ment or" following the word "the" in line two (2) thereof.  
 5 b. By inserting a period after the word "hereof" in line eleven,  
 6 (11) and striking out the remainder of the section.  
 7 c. By adding to said section the following:  
 8 "The provisions of chapter two hundred thirty-seven (237) of the  
 9 code, 1927, shall not apply to the establishment, vacation, alteration  
 10 or improvement of primary roads. No such roads shall be established  
 11 through any cemetery or burying ground without the consent of all  
 12 of the parties affected by the same, nor shall any ground be taken  
 13 for the rounding of a corner where the dwelling house, lawn and  
 14 ornamental trees connected therewith are located at such corner,  
 15 except by consent of the owner thereof. Upon the completion of a  
 16 primary road paving project, or upon the completion of a grading  
 17 project on a primary road that is not to be paved, the state highway  
 18 commission shall file with the auditor and with the recorder of the  
 19 county in which such project is located, a complete right of way map  
 20 of said project. Said right of way maps shall be filed by the auditor  
 21 and recorder and shall become a part of the permanent records of  
 22 such offices."
