CHAPTER 38

ELECTIONS

AN ACT to amend section six hundred ninety (690) of the code, 1927, in relation to registrars acting in the dual duty of registrar and clerk of election.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. That section six hundred ninety (690) of the code, 1927, be amended by striking out all the words after the words "election
- 3 day" in the tenth line and inserting in lieu thereof the words: "shall
- 4 be at the regular polling places and the duties to be performed by 5 the registrars shall be that of registration and to also act as clerks 6 of election."

CHAPTER 39

ELECTIONS

AN ACT to amend section eight hundred ninety-three (893), code, 1927, relating to the duties of double election boards.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section eight-hundred ninety-three (893), code, 1927, is amended by striking out the first sentence and by inserting in lieu
- 3 thereof the following:
- The counting boards shall proceed to the respective voting places to which they have been appointed, at one (1) o'clock P. M., or in any precinct in which the board of supervisors shall deem it necessary.
- 6 precinct in which the board of supervisors shall deem it necessary, 7 at such earlier hour after nine (9) o'clock A. M., as such board of supervisors may direct, and shall take charge of the ballot box con-
- 9 taining the ballots already cast in that precinct when at least fifty

10 (50) ballots have been cast.
