

CHAPTER 72

BARBERING

AN ACT to amend the law as it appears in section twenty-five hundred eighty-five-b thirteen (2585-b13) of the code of 1927, relating to the requirements for license to practice barbering.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. That the law as it appears in section twenty-five hun-
 2 dred eighty-five-b thirteen (2585-b13) of the code of 1927, be amended
 3 by adding at the end thereof the following:
 4 "4. Present to the barber examiners satisfactory evidence that
 5 he is a citizen of the United States, or has made application for citi-
 6 zenship."

CHAPTER 73

DISEASED CATTLE

AN ACT to amend the law as it appears in section twenty-six hundred fifty-three (2653) of the code of Iowa, 1927, relating to importation of livestock into the state.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. That the law as it appears in section twenty-six hun-
 2 dred fifty-three (2653) of the code of Iowa, 1927, be and the same is
 3 hereby amended by inserting after the period (.) after the word "dis-
 4 eases" in line seven (7) thereof, the following:
 5 "No person shall bring in any manner into this state any cattle for
 6 dairy or breeding purposes unless such cattle have been tested within
 7 thirty days prior to date of importation by the agglutination test for
 8 contagious abortion, or abortion disease, and shown to be free from
 9 such disease."

CHAPTER 74

BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS

AN ACT to amend the law as it appears in section twenty-six hundred ninety (2690) of the code of Iowa, 1927, relating to the eradication of bovine tuberculosis and to provide for the regulation of the importation into this state of cattle whether or not they have been tested for such disease, as provided in chapter one hundred twenty-nine (129) of the code, 1927, as amended.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. That the law as it appears in chapter one hundred
 2 twenty-nine (129) of the code of Iowa, 1927, be and the same is here-
 3 by amended by adding thereto the following:
