

## CHAPTER 177

## ASSESSMENTS FOR MAIN SEWERS

AN ACT to amend section fifty-nine hundred and eighty-six (5986), as it appears in the code of 1927, relating to assessments for the construction of main sewers.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. That section fifty-nine hundred eighty-six (5986) of  
2 the code, 1927, be amended by inserting after the word "thousand"  
3 in line three the following: "and cities having a population in excess  
4 of one hundred twenty-five thousand".

1 SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be  
2 in effect from and after its publication in the Des Moines Daily Rec-  
3 ord, a newspaper published in Des Moines, Iowa, and the Plain Talk,  
4 a newspaper published in Des Moines, Iowa.

## CHAPTER 178

## CITIES AND TOWNS. CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS

AN ACT to amend section fifty-nine hundred and eighty-nine (5989), as it appears in the code of 1927, relating to the condemnation by cities of private property for right of way for sewers.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. That section fifty-nine hundred and eighty-nine (5989),  
2 as it appears in the code of 1927, be amended by striking therefrom  
3 all that part of said section between the word "property" in the fourth  
4 line of said section and the word "sufficient" in the fifth line of said  
5 section, the part of said section so to be stricken reading as follows:  
6 "to and along ravines and natural watercourses".

1 SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in  
2 effect from and after its publication in the Des Moines Daily Record,  
3 a newspaper published in Des Moines, Iowa, and the Plain Talk, a  
4 newspaper published in Des Moines, Iowa.
