

CHAPTER 243

CEMETERIES

AN ACT to amend the law as it appears in sections ten thousand two hundred eleven (10211), ten thousand two hundred twelve (10212) and ten thousand two hundred thirteen (10213) of the code, 1927, relating to the management of cemetery funds by trustees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. That the law as it appears in section ten thousand two
2 hundred eleven (10211) of the code, 1927, be and the same is hereby
3 amended by inserting the word "Counties" at the beginning of said
4 section.

1 SEC. 2. That the law as it appears in section ten thousand two
2 hundred twelve (10212) of the code, 1927, be and the same is hereby
3 amended by inserting the words "board of supervisors" before the
4 word "mayor" in the first line of said section.

1 SEC. 3. That the law as it appears in section ten thousand two hun-
2 dred thirteen (10213) of the code, 1927, be and the same is hereby
3 amended by inserting the word "county" before the word "city" in
4 the second line of said section and also by adding at the close of said
5 section the following sentence:

6 "In case there is no cemetery association then the income from said
7 fund shall be expended under the direction of the board of supervisors
8 in accordance with the terms of said donation or bequest."

CHAPTER 244

SERVICES ON PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

AN ACT to amend section ten thousand two hundred ninety-nine (10299) of the code of Iowa, 1927, relating to the furnishing of labor and services in connection with public improvements.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. That the law as it appears in section ten thousand two
2 hundred ninety-nine (10299) of the code of Iowa, 1927, be and the
3 same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "feed", in line
4 eighteen, the following: ", gasoline, kerosene, lubricating oils and
5 greases."

1 SEC. 2. That the law as it appears in section ten thousand two
2 hundred ninety-nine (10299) of the code of Iowa, 1927, be and the
3 same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following as para-
4 graph five (5):

5 5. "Service" shall, in addition to its ordinary meaning, include the
6 furnishing to the contractor of workmen's compensation insurance,
7 and premiums and charges for such insurance shall be considered a
8 claim for service.
