

CHAPTER 301

EXPENSES NATIONAL ENCAMPMENT

AN ACT making an appropriation for the purpose of aiding in defraying the expenses of a national encampment of the grand army of the republic to be held in this state.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the
2 state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of fifteen thousand
3 dollars (\$15,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used
4 in defraying the expenses of a national encampment of the grand
5 army of the republic to be held in Iowa, during the years nineteen
6 hundred thirty (1930) or nineteen hundred thirty-one (1931), such
7 funds to be paid out upon order of the executive council upon the
8 filing with the executive council of itemized claims showing the ex-
9 pense has been incurred, such claims to be approved by the state
10 commander and quartermaster of the grand army of the republic.

CHAPTER 302

CORN BORER

AN ACT to make an appropriation for the prevention, control, and eradication of the European corn borer, including incidental and miscellaneous expenses connected therewith.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated for the period ending
2 July first (1st), nineteen hundred thirty-one (1931), from any funds
3 in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one
4 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary for the purpose of preventing the introducing into this
6 state of the European corn borer, for the purpose of controlling and
7 eradicating said pest, for the purpose of defraying the necessary
8 expense of printing, supplies, salaries and expenses of assistants to
9 the state entomologist, and for any other purpose necessarily con-
10 nected with said activities. Said appropriation shall be wholly avail-
11 able immediately upon the taking effect of this act and may be ex-
12 pended, if necessary by and under the direction of the secretary of
13 agriculture of this state with the approval of the executive council
14 and the director of the budget.
