

## CHAPTER 328

## HOPPER FURNITURE COMPANY

AN ACT to make an appropriation to the C. T. Hopper Furniture Company for damages to an automobile in collision with a truck operated by the Iowa state highway commission.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the C. T. Hopper Furni-  
2 ture Company of Sioux City, Iowa, the sum of sixty-seven and 20/100  
3 (\$67.20) for damages to an automobile as a result of a collision with  
4 a truck operated by the Iowa state highway commission on the Lin-  
5 coln highway between Arion and Dow City on January 11, 1929; and  
6 the auditor of state is hereby authorized to draw his warrant to the  
7 said company for said amount, and the treasurer of state is hereby  
8 authorized and directed to pay the same out of the primary road fund  
9 of the state of Iowa.

1 SEC. 2. The receipt of the said sum by the said C. T. Hopper Furni-  
2 ture Company shall be in full settlement of any and all claims against  
3 the state of Iowa on account of said damages.

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CHAPTER 329

## WILLIAM J. HUDGEL

AN ACT to make an appropriation to William J. Hudgel.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the  
2 state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to William J. Hudgel, the  
3 sum of four hundred eighty-five dollars (\$485.00), for damages grow-  
4 ing out of injury at the Iowa State Fair grounds on August 26, 1927;  
5 and the auditor of state is hereby authorized to draw his warrant  
6 for said amount in favor of the said William J. Hudgel, and the treas-  
7 urer of state is hereby authorized and directed to pay the same as  
8 aforesaid.

1 SEC. 2. The receipt of the said sum by the said William J. Hudgel  
2 shall be in full settlement of any and all claims against the state of  
3 Iowa on account of said injury.

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
