

1 SEC. 2. The receipt of the said sum by the said Kai Sommer shall  
2 be in full settlement of all claims growing out of said collision against  
3 the state of Iowa or the Iowa state highway commission.

1 SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be  
2 in full force and effect from and after its publication in the Bystander,  
3 a newspaper published in Des Moines, Iowa, and in Gowrie News, a  
4 newspaper published in Gowrie, Iowa, without expense to the state.

#### CHAPTER 347

JOHN A. STEWART

AN ACT to make appropriation to John A. Stewart for compensation and traveling  
expenses while in the service of the Iowa national guard.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the  
2 state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five hundred  
3 thirty-five and 32/100 dollars (\$535.32), to John A. Stewart, for com-  
4 pensation and traveling expenses while in the service of the Iowa  
5 national guard on assignment to the federal government, but which  
6 the federal government refused to pay for the reason that the organi-  
7 zation did not provide for such officer; and the auditor of state is  
8 hereby authorized to draw his warrant for said amount in favor of  
9 the said John A. Stewart, and the treasurer of state is hereby author-  
10 ized and directed to pay the same as aforesaid.

1 SEC. 2. The receipt of the said sum by the said John A. Stewart  
2 shall be in full settlement of any and all claims against the state of  
3 Iowa on account of said claim for military service.

AN ACT to make an appropriation to Stipp, Perry, Bannister & Starzinger, and Senneff,

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the

4 (\$6,000.00), for legal services and expenses as attorneys for the
