- shall be selected, and such person shall act accordingly until a president or vice president shall have qualified. 11
- "SEC. 4. The congress may by law provide for the case of the death of any of the persons from whom the house of representatives may choose a president whenever the right of choice shall have de-
- volved upon them, and for the case of the death of any of the persons from whom the senate may choose a vice president whenever the right
- of choice shall have devolved upon them.
- Sections 1 and 2 shall take effect on the 15th day of 1 October following the ratification of this article.
- This article shall be inoperative unless it shall have been ratified as an amendment to the constitution by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several states within seven years from the date of its submission."

Now. therefore.

Be it enacted and resolved by the general assembly of the state of Iowa that said proposed amendment to the constitution of the United States of America as set forth herein under sections one (1) to six (6), inclusive, of the said resolution of the said congress, is hereby ratified and consented to by the state of Iowa and by the general assembly thereof.

Be it further resolved and enacted that copies of this enactment and resolution, duly certified to by the governor of the state of Iowa and attested by the secretary of state of the state of Iowa, under the seal of the said state, be forthwith forwarded by said governor to the secretary of state of the United States, and to the presiding officers of each house of the congress of the United States.

CHAPTER 268

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. STATE CENSUS

S. J. R. 5

JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to article three (III) of the constitution of the state of Iowa by repealing section thirty-three (33) relating to the state census.

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

That the constitution of Iowa be amended as follows:

- SECTION 1. Amend article three (III) by repealing section thirtythree (33) relating to the state census.
- SEC. 2. Be it further resolved that the foregoing proposed amend-
- ment be, and the same is hereby, referred to the general assembly to be chosen at the next general election and that the secretary of state cause the same to be published as provided by law.
