100 title, and also when the affidavit accompanying the application of such
101 licensee for renewal of license filed with the department is not in all
102 respects true.

103 "16. Unprofessional conduct. As to dentists and dental hygienists
104 'unprofessional conduct' shall consist of any of the acts denominated
105 as such elsewhere in this title, and also any other of the following
106 acts:

107 a. All advertising of any kind or character other than the carrying
108 or publishing of a professional card or the display of a window or
109 street sign at the licensee's place of business; which professional card
110 or window or street sign shall display only the name, address, profes-
111 sion, office hours and telephone connections of the licensee.

112 b. Exploiting or advertising through the press, on the radio, or by
113 the use of handbills, circulars or periodicals, other than professional
114 cards stating only the name, address, profession, office hours and tele-
115 phone connections of the licensee.

116 c. Employing or making use of advertising solicitors or publicity
117 agents or soliciting employment personally or by representative.

118 "17. Application. The provisions hereof shall not in any wise apply
119 to acts done or violations of law committed prior to the enactment
120 hereof."

1 SEC. 5. Constitutionality. If any portion hereof should be ad-
2 judged to be unconstitutional or for any other reason invalid, the
3 other provisions hereof shall be and remain in full force and effect.

1 SEC. 6. All acts, or parts of acts, in conflict herewith are hereby
2 repealed.

1 SEC. 7. Publication. This act being of immediate importance shall
2 be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the Sioux
3 City Tribune, a newspaper published in the city of Sioux City, Iowa,
4 and the Fort Dodge Messenger, a newspaper published in the city of
5 Fort Dodge, Iowa.

CHAPTER 25

OPTOMETRY. APPROVED SCHOOLS

S. F. 182

AN ACT to amend section twenty-five hundred seventy-seven (2577), code, 1931, relating
to approved schools of optometry.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. That section twenty-five hundred seventy-seven (2577),
2 code, 1931, be amended by striking the word "two" in line 6 and insert-
3 ing in lieu thereof the word "three."
