H. L. HELLER, ET AL.

AN ACT to make an appropriation to H. L. Heller, M. V. Harmon, L. C. Syfert, W. M. Cutter, Carl Weeks, Walter Kiser, Joe Michels, E. E. Peterson, E. Kennedy, Carl R. Ryder, Elsie Maden, Mrs. J. H. Kelley, and H. M. Kelley.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road
2 fund to H. L. Heller of Ottumwa, Iowa, the sum of two (2) dollars in
3 full settlement of damages on account of collision with highway com-
4 mission snow plow on primary road number 34 in Jefferson county on
5 November 30, 1934.

1 SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to M. V. Harmon of Des Moines, Iowa, the sum of nineteen (19) dollars
3 in full settlement of damages due to collision with highway commis-
4 sion truck on primary road number 6 in Jasper county on January
5 22, 1935.

1 SEC. 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to L. C. Syfert, Keosauqua, Iowa, the sum of thirty-three (33) dollars
3 and forty-four (44) cents in full settlement of damages due to colli-
4 sion with highway commission car on primary road number 1 in Van
5 Buren county on May 14, 1934.

1 SEC. 4. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to W. M. Cutter, the sum of ten (10) dollars and forty-three (43) cents
3 in full settlement of damages to automobile due to collision with high-
4 way commission truck, which occurred on primary road number 34 in
5 Jefferson county on December 19, 1934.

1 SEC. 5. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to Carl Weeks of Des Moines, Iowa, the sum of eight (8) dollars and
3 thirty-four (34) cents in full settlement of damages to automobile
4 through collision with highway commission car in Indianola, Iowa,
5 December 31, 1934.

1 SEC. 6. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to Walter Kiser of Wilton Junction, Iowa, the sum of twenty-four (24)
3 dollars and twenty-six (26) cents in full settlement of damages to
4 Chevrolet truck as a result of collision with highway commission mo-
5 tor patrol on primary road number 38 in Cedar county, on July 23, 1934.

1 SEC. 7. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to Joe Michels of Springbrook, Iowa, the sum of four (4) dollars and
3 twenty-five (25) cents in full settlement of damages to his automobile
4 as a result of collision with a highway commission motor patrol on
5 primary road number 55 in Jackson county on February 8, 1935.

1 SEC. 8. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to E. E. Peterson, Murray, Iowa, the sum of thirty-six (36) dollars and
3 fifty-eight (58) cents in full settlement of damages to his Oldsmobile
4 coupe as a result of collision with a highway commission snow plow on
5 primary road number 65 in Warren county, January 16, 1935.

1 SEC. 9. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to Ed Kennedy of Coon Rapids, Iowa, the sum of ten (10) dollars in
3 full settlement of damages to his automobile as a result of a collision
4 with a highway commission automobile in Jefferson, Iowa, December
5 16, 1934.

1 SEC. 10. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to Carl R. Ryder of Des Moines, Iowa, the sum of nineteen (19) dollars
3 and thirty-seven (37) cents in full settlement of damages to his
4 Plymouth coupe sustained when struck by gravel thrown from high-
5 way commission truck on primary highway number 6 in Polk county,
6 December 10, 1934.

1 SEC. 11. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to Elsie Maden of Brighton, Iowa, the sum of eight (8) dollars and
3 fifty (50) cents in full settlement of damages to her automobile sus-
4 tained as a result of a collision with a highway commission power
5 maintainer in Washington, Iowa, on February 23, 1935.

1 SEC. 12. There is hereby appropriated out of the primary road fund
2 to Mrs. J. H. Kelley and H. M. Kelley, Washington, Iowa, the sum of
3 three hundred fifty-four (354) dollars and forty (40) cents in full
4 settlement of the claim of the former on account of personal injuries
5 and in full settlement of the claim of the latter on account of damages
6 and expense incidental and growing out of a collision with a highway
7 commission snow plow on primary road number 2 in Keokuk county
8 on January 13, 1934.

1 SEC. 13. The state comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to
2 draw his several warrants in favor of the above named parties re-
3 spectively, in payment of the above appropriations, and the treasurer
4 of state is hereby directed to pay said claims out of the primary road
5 fund.

1 SEC. 14. Receipt by the above named parties respectively, of the
2 amounts herein appropriated to them shall be in full settlement of any
3 and all claims and demands held by them against the state of Iowa
4 on any and all accounts whatsoever and particularly on account of the
5 items specifically referred to in this act.
