GENERAL ASSEMBLY. COMPENSATION, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

A JOINT RESOLUTION fixing the compensation of officers and employees of the Forty-sixth General Assembly.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of section nineteen (19) of
2 the code, 1931, it is provided that the daily compensation of all officers
3 and employees of the Forty-sixth General Assembly be as follows, to be
4 paid in accordance with the rules of the senate and house:

1 SEC. 2. It is further provided that the president and secretary of the
2 senate and the speaker and chief clerk of the house shall be authorized
3 to pay compensation to persons acting as temporary officers or employ-
4 ees, prior to the permanent organization of their respective houses, in
5 the positions set forth in section one (1) and at the same scale of com-
6 pensation as set forth therein.

1 SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in
2 force and effect from and after its publication in the Ottumwa Daily
3 Courier, a newspaper published at Ottumwa, Iowa, and in the Newton
4 Daily News, a newspaper published at Newton, Iowa.
