## CHAPTER 279

## EAST WATERLOO HOTEL COMPANY

### H. F. 154

AN ACT to legalize the corporate acts and renewal of the charter of the East Waterloo Hotel Company, of Waterloo, Iowa.

WHEREAS, at the expiration of the corporate existence of the East Waterloo Hotel Company, Waterloo, Iowa, a corporation organized under the laws of Iowa, renewal articles were not filed with the secretary of state in full compliance with the statutes relating to renewals, specifically within the time limitation prescribed for such renewal; and

WHEREAS, the said corporation has now filed such renewal articles and tendered the statutory fees therefor and otherwise complied with the law, except as to the time of filing; now, therefore,

## Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. The proceedings of the East Waterloo Hotel Company, of Waterloo, Iowa, with respect to renewal of said corporation are 3 hereby legalized and declared of the same force and effect as though they were had in full compliance with the laws of Iowa relating to
- renewals.
- SEC. 2. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to issue to the said East Waterloo Hotel Company a certificate of renewal which shall have the same effect as though issued upon proper application by said corporation.
- SEC. 3. Nothing in this act shall be deemed or construed to affect pending litigation, if any, involving said corporation.
- SEC. 4. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Waterloo Daily Courier, published in Waterloo, Iowa, and in the Cedar Falls Record, published in Cedar Falls, Iowa, and without expense to the 4 5 state.
