CHAPTER 4

BOARD OF EDUCATION APPROPRIATION

H. F. 288

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the State of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943, to the board of education for the support of institutions under said board of education.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and
 3 ending June 30, 1943, for the board of education for state institutions
 4 for salaries, support, maintenance, repairs, replacements or alterations
 5 of all institutions under the control of said board, the sum of six million
 6 eight hundred twenty-two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$6,822,800.-
 7 00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, and for the following
 8 purposes, to wit:

(1) STATE UNIVERSITY OF IOWA
 Iowa City

9 For the state university of Iowa there is hereby appropriated from
 10 the general fund of the state for each year of the biennium beginning
 11 July 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943, the sum of two million three
 12 hundred forty thousand dollars (\$2,340,000.00) or so much thereof as
 13 may be necessary to be used in the following manner:

14 For salaries, support and maintenance.....\$2,277,500.00
 15 For repairs, replacements and alterations..... 62,500.00

16 Total for state university of Iowa.....\$2,340,000.00

(2) IOWA STATE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND MECHANICAL ARTS
 Ames

17 For the Iowa state college of agriculture and mechanical arts there

18 is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for each
 19 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943,
 20 the sum of two million three hundred twenty-five thousand dollars
 21 (\$2,325,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used in
 22 the following manner:

23	For salaries, support and maintenance.....	\$2,215,000.00
24	For repairs, replacements or alterations.....	110,000.00

(3) IOWA STATE TEACHERS COLLEGE

Cedar Falls

27 For the Iowa state teachers college there is hereby appropriated from
 28 the general fund of the state for each year of the biennium beginning
 29 July 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943, the sum of six hundred fifty-
 30 seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$657,500.00) or so much thereof
 31 as may be necessary to be used in the following manner:

32	For salaries, support and maintenance.....	\$ 648,500.00
33	For repairs, replacements or alterations.....	9,000.00

(4) IOWA SCHOOL FOR DEAF

Council Bluffs

35 For the Iowa school for deaf there is hereby appropriated from the
 36 general fund of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July
 37 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943, the sum of two hundred twenty-five
 38 thousand dollars (\$225,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary
 39 to be used in the following manner:

40	For salaries, support and maintenance.....	\$ 222,900.00
41	For repairs, replacements or alterations.....	2,100.00

(5) IOWA SCHOOL FOR BLIND

Vinton

43 For the Iowa school for blind there is hereby appropriated from the
 44 general fund of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July
 45 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943, the sum of one hundred twenty-six
 46 thousand three hundred dollars (\$126,300.00) or so much thereof as
 47 may be necessary to be used in the following manner:

48	For salaries, support and maintenance.....	\$ 124,000.00
49	For furniture, equipment, etc.....	2,300.00

(6) MEDICAL AND SURGICAL TREATMENT OF INDIGENT PATIENTS

University Hospital

51 For the purpose of carrying out the purpose of chapter 189.7, code,
 52 1939, there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state
 53 for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and ending June

54 30, 1943, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much
55 thereof as may be necessary to be expended in the manner and under
56 the authority provided in said chapter.

(7) PSYCHOPATHIC HOSPITAL

57 For the psychopathic hospital, at Iowa City, there is hereby appro-
58 priated from the general fund of the state for each year of the biennium
59 beginning July 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943, the sum of one
60 hundred eight thousand dollars (\$108,000.00) or so much thereof as
61 may be necessary to be expended in the manner and under the authority
62 provided in chapter 173.1, provided however that the amounts shall
63 be available in monthly installments not exceeding nine thousand
64 dollars (\$9,000.00) and that said installments shall be expended only
65 upon submission of bills in the manner provided in section 3482.28 of
66 said chapter.

(8) BACTERIOLOGICAL AND HYGENIC LABORATORY

State Department of Health

67 For the bacteriological and hygenic laboratory of the state depart-
68 ment of health there is hereby appropriated from the general fund
69 of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and
70 ending June 30, 1943, the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00)
71 or so much thereof as may be necessary to provide for public health
72 examinations, such as bacteriological, water, and serological tests, to
73 determine the cause of infectious diseases, the origin and control of
74 epidemics throughout the state of Iowa.

(9) SOLDIERS TUITION

75 There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state
76 for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and ending June
77 30, 1943, the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or so much there-
78 of as may be necessary for payment of tuition for honorably discharged
79 soldiers or sailors of the world war of the United States who are
80 citizens of Iowa who enroll in any division of the state university at
81 Iowa City, or the college of agriculture and mechanical arts at Ames,
82 said payments being fixed at twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each student
83 for each semester and each summer school.
