1 SEC. 2. For the Board of Control there is hereby appropriated from  
 2 the general fund of the state for each year of the biennium beginning  
 3 July 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943, the sum of fifty thousand  
 4 dollars (\$50,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
 5 salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes at the  
 6 institutions at Glenwood and Woodward, the availability of this appro-  
 7 priation being conditioned upon the enactment into law by the Forty-  
 8 ninth General Assembly of House File 289. In the event House File  
 9 289 is not enacted into law this appropriation will not be available.

1 SEC. 3. There is hereby appropriated a sum sufficient to pay the  
 2 per diem compensation made necessary by House Concurrent Resolu-  
 3 tion 34 for services required by officers and employees of the Forty-  
 4 ninth General Assembly after final adjournment.

1 SEC. 4. There is hereby appropriated for the emergency of im-  
 2 mediate care of the state archives, their temporary protection and  
 3 safeguarding from the danger of fire and the ravages of the elements,  
 4 to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of the State  
 5 department of history and archives, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars  
 6 (\$15,000.00).

1 SEC. 5. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in  
 2 full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the  
 3 Argo Gazette, a newspaper published at West Union, Iowa, and the  
 4 Cedar Falls Daily Record, a newspaper published at Cedar Falls, Iowa.

## CHAPTER 10

### APPROPRIATION FOR SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AT VINTON

H. F. 397

AN ACT to make an appropriation from the general fund of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943, to the board of education for improvement and equipment at the school for the blind, Vinton, and providing for the manner of expenditure thereof.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund  
 2 of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and ending June  
 3 30, 1943, to the board of education, thirty-five thousand dollars

4 (\$35,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in  
5 the following manner:

SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND

Vinton

6 To construct addition to gymnasium including  
7 swimming pool and equipment.....\$35,000.00

1 SEC. 2. All funds appropriated hereunder shall be expended only  
2 in the following manner: the plans and specifications for the improve-  
3 ment and equipment for which funds are herein appropriated shall  
4 first, before any work has been done, have the express approval of the  
5 executive council, and before final payments are made, said final pay-  
6 ments shall be approved by the executive council.

CHAPTER 11

WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

S. F. 206

AN ACT to appropriate money to meet a deficit in the workmen's compensation service department relating to the administration of the Workmen's Compensation Law, under chapters seventy (70), seventy-one (71) and seventy-two (72) of the Code, 1939.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of  
2 the State not otherwise appropriated, four thousand five hundred  
3 dollars (\$4,500.00) to be credited to the Industrial Commissioner for  
4 use by him for the payment of workmen's compensation benefits to  
5 which injured state employees are entitled under Chapters seventy  
6 (70) seventy-one (71) and seventy-two (72), Code, 1939, other than  
7 injured employees of the State Highway Commission and Liquor Com-  
8 mission and peace officers. Any amount herein appropriated and not  
9 required for use to meet the accrued expense for the biennial period  
10 ending June 30, 1941, shall revert to the general funds of the State of  
11 Iowa.

1 SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall be in  
2 full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the  
3 Cedar Falls Record, a newspaper published at Cedar Falls, and in the  
4 Reinbeck Courier, a newspaper published at Reinbeck, Iowa.
