

19 shall meet and organize on the second Monday in May, 1941, and at
 20 the same time and immediately following its organization, meet with
 21 the executive council in order that the committee and council may
 22 advise on carrying out the provisions of this act.

1 SEC. 5. Each member of the legislative advisory committee shall be
 2 entitled to such hotel and traveling expenses incurred in the discharge
 3 of their duties and such allowance for time spent in the discharge of
 4 their duties as may be allowed by the 50th General Assembly.

1 SEC. 6. In the event that the executive council and the legislative
 2 advisory committee shall in their discretion determine that it would
 3 not be to the best interests of the state to proceed with the erection of
 4 said building during the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, the moneys
 5 appropriated by this act shall be segregated in a fund to be known as
 6 the State Office Building Fund to be used for the purposes provided
 7 in this act at such future time as the executive council and the legisla-
 8 tive advisory committee may determine, and said fund, if not previously
 9 expended for the purposes provided herein, shall not revert to the
 10 general fund until such time as the General Assembly may by act or
 11 joint resolution provide therefor, anything in any other act or law to
 12 the contrary notwithstanding.

1 SEC. 7. If any section, subsection, clause, sentence or phrase of this
 2 act is for any reason held to be unconstitutional and invalid, such
 3 decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this
 4 act. The legislature hereby declares that it would have passed this
 5 act and each section, subsection, clause, sentence or phrase hereof,
 6 irrespective of whether any one or more of the sections, subsections,
 7 clauses, sentences, or phrases be declared unconstitutional.

1 SEC. 8. Insofar as section three (3), Chapter fourteen (14) of the
 2 Acts of the Thirty-fifth General Assembly is in conflict with this act,
 3 the same is hereby repealed.

1 SEC. 9. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be-
 2 come effective upon publication in the Centerville Daily Iowegian, a
 3 newspaper published at Centerville, Iowa, and in the Clinton Herald,
 4 a newspaper published at Clinton, Iowa.

CHAPTER 17

STATE UNIVERSITY LIBRARY BUILDING APPROPRIATION

S. F. 526

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the state, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1943, to the board of education for improvement and equipment at the State University of Iowa, Iowa City.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1941, and
3 ending June 30, 1943, the sum of One hundred and fifty thousand
4 dollars (\$150,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to be
5 used in the following manner:

6 To construct and equip the first unit of a Central
7 Library Building\$150,000.00.

CHAPTER 18

APPROPRIATION FOR AGRICULTURAL ENGINEERING LABORATORIES BUILDING AT IOWA STATE COLLEGE

H. F. 558

AN ACT to appropriate from the Fund provided by section fifty-one (51), chapter one (1), Acts of the Forty-eighth General Assembly, to the board of education for improvements and equipment at the Iowa State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts at Ames, and providing for the manner of expenditure thereof.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. All funds appropriated herein shall be expended only
2 in the following manner: The plans and specifications for the improve-
3 ment and equipment for which funds are herein appropriated shall
4 first, before any work has been done, have the express approval of the
5 executive council and the joint committee on retrenchment and reform,
6 and before final payments are made said final payments shall be
7 approved by the executive council and the joint committee on re-
8 trenchment and reform.

1 SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the fund provided by
2 Section fifty-one (51), Chapter one (1), Acts of the Forty-Eighth
3 General Assembly, to the board of education the sum of one hundred
4 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000.00), or as much thereof as
5 may be necessary, to be used in the following manner:

6 For the construction of an agricultural engineer-
7 ing laboratories building at the Iowa State Col-
8 lege of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts.....\$105,000.00
9 For equipment in said laboratory building..... 20,000.00

10 Total appropriation for the biennium hereunder...\$125,000.00

1 SEC. 3. The said funds appropriated herein shall be available at any
2 time during the biennium as may be directed by the executive council
3 and the joint committee on retrenchment and reform.
