## CHAPTER 23

### APPROPRIATION FOR NATIONAL DEFENSE CONFERENCE DELEGATE

H. F. 523

AN ACT making an appropriation to defray the expense of sending delegates to the National Defense Conference.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the  
 2 state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of one hundred  
 3 twenty-nine dollars and sixty-five cents (\$129.65) to pay the expenses  
 4 of delegates sent to the National Defense conference. Warrants shall  
 5 be drawn upon the treasury for the sum herein appropriated in favor  
 6 of the following persons and in the sum set out opposite their name  
 7 upon the filing of vouchers therefor with the State Comptroller.
