

1 SEC. 4. For the purpose of this act the word "state" shall include
2 the District of Columbia.

1 SEC. 5. The term "fresh pursuit" as used in this act shall include
2 fresh pursuit as defined by the common law, and also the pursuit of a
3 person who has committed a felony or who is reasonably suspected of
4 having committed a felony. It shall also include the pursuit of a
5 person suspected of having committed a supposed felony, though no
6 felony has actually been committed, if there is reasonable ground for
7 believing that a felony has been committed. Fresh pursuit as used
8 herein shall not necessarily imply instant pursuit, but pursuit without
9 unreasonable delay.

1 SEC. 6. Upon the passage and approval by the governor of this
2 act, it shall be the duty of the secretary of state to certify a copy of
3 this act to the executive department of each of the states of the United
4 States.

1 SEC. 7. If any part of this act is for any reason declared void, it
2 is declared to be the intent of this act that such invalidity shall not
3 affect the validity of the remaining portions of this act.

1 SEC. 8. This act may be cited as the Uniform Act on Fresh Pursuit.

CHAPTER 96

WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

S. F. 86

AN ACT to amend sections one thousand four hundred twenty-one (1421) and one thousand four hundred twenty-two (1422), Code, 1939, relating to workmen's compensation, and defining as "employees" members of the Iowa Highway Safety Patrol.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. That section one thousand four hundred twenty-one
2 (1421), Code, 1939, be amended by striking the period (.) at the end of
3 subparagraph d of subsection three (3) and insert a comma (,) in lieu
4 thereof, and by adding the following: "except members of the Iowa
5 highway safety patrol."

1 SEC. 2. That section one thousand four hundred twenty-two (1422),
2 Code, 1939, be amended by inserting in line six (6) after the comma
3 (,) following the word "officers" the following: "except members of
4 the Iowa highway safety patrol,".
