CHAPTER 9.

POOR FARM.

AN ACT to authorize the county Judge of Lee county, Iowa, to sell or otherwise dispose of the County or Poor Farm in said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the county Judge of Lee county, is hereby authorized to sell, or otherwise dispose of the lands belonging to said county, and now used for the purpose of a poor farm, containing one hundred and thirty acres, more or less; make a title to the purchaser or purchasers thereof, and hand over the proceeds to the Treasurer of said county. Judge may sell. Deed. Proceeds.

§ 2. That said county Judge is also hereby authorized, after having made a sale or disposition of the lands described in the foregoing section, to purchase, in the name of said county, other lands in said county, for the purpose of a poor farm, and proceed to erect and establish buildings thereon. Purchase other. Erect buildings.

§ 3. This Act to take effect from and after its passage.
