## CHAPTER 88.

### STATE ROAD.

AN ACT to locate and establish a certain State Road therein named.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the* <sup>Commission-</sup> *State of Iowa,* That Simon Archer, of Linn county, James <sup>ers.</sup> Buchanan and Cyrus Sanders, of Johnson county, be, and they are hereby appointed Commissioners, to locate and es- <sup>Lisbon to Io-</sup> tablish a State Road from Lisbon, in Linn county, to Iowa <sup>wa City.</sup> City, in Johnson county.

§ 2. The Commissioners hereby appointed shall meet at <sup>Time & place</sup> Iowa City, on the first Tuesday in April next, or within <sup>of meeting.</sup> thirty days thereafter, who, after being sworn to the faithful discharge of their duties, shall take to their aid necessary assistance, and proceed to locate and establish such road: *Provided,* the expense of locating said road shall be paid by <sup>Expens.</sup> the counties of Linn and Johnson.

§ 3. This act to be in force from and after its publica- <sup>Take effect.</sup> tion in the Iowa City newspapers.
