MAIL FACILITIES.

JOINT RESOLUTION to procure additional mail facilities.

Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, instruction. That our Senators be instructed, and our Representatives in Congress be requested to use their influence, to procure increased mail facilities, on the route from Mt. Pleasant, in Mt. Pleasant, Henry county, via Trenton, Deedsville, Brighton, and Rich to Oskaloosa. land, to Oskaloosa, in Mahaska county; so as to have the Tri-Weekly. mail conveyed three times week, in hacks or coaches.

Resolved, That the Secretary of State be instructed to send Secretary is structed to fora copy of these resolutions to our Senators and Representatives, in Congress and to the Post Master General.
