CHAPTER 2  
 APPROPRIATIONS

S. F. 337

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1943, and ending June 30, 1945, to the board of education for the support, repairs, replacement or alterations of institutions under said board of education.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund  
 2 of the state for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1943, and  
 3 ending June 30, 1945, for the board of education for state institutions  
 4 for salaries, support, maintenance, repairs, replacements or altera-  
 5 tions of all institutions under the control of said board, the sum of  
 6 seven million six hundred forty-eight thousand three hundred dollars  
 7 (\$7,648,300.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, and for the  
 8 following purposes to-wit:

(1) STATE UNIVERSITY OF IOWA  
 IOWA CITY

9	For the state university of Iowa there is hereby appropriated from	
10	the general fund of the state for each year of the biennium beginning	
11	July 1, 1943, and ending June 30, 1945, the sum of two million five	
12	hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$2,580,000.00) or so much thereof	
13	as may be necessary to be used in the following manner:	
14	(a) For salaries, support and maintenance.....	\$2,360,000.00
15	(b) For repairs, replacements or alterations.....	75,000.00
16	(c) For salary and wage increases to employees re-	
17	ceiving less than \$2000 annually, but in no case	
18	shall any salary affected under this item be in-	
19	creased to exceed \$2000.....	145,000.00
20	Total for the State University of Iowa.....	\$2,580,000.00

(2) IOWA STATE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND  
MECHANIC ARTS  
AMES

21 For the Iowa State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts  
22 there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the State for  
23 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1943, and ending June  
24 30, 1945, the sum of two million six hundred forty-two thousand five  
25 hundred dollars (\$2,642,500.00) or so much thereof as may be neces-  
26 sary to be used in the following manner:

27	(a) For salaries, support and maintenance.....	\$2,300,000.00
28	(b) For repairs, replacements or alterations.....	122,500.00
29	(c) For salary and wage increases to employees re- 30 ceiving less than \$2000 annually, but in no case 31 shall any salary affected under this item be in- 32 creased to exceed \$2000.....	150,000.00

33 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
34 Treasury, out of any funds not otherwise appropriated  
35 to the Iowa State College of Agriculture and Mechanic  
36 Arts, for each year of the biennium beginning July 1,  
37 1943, an additional sum of seventy thousand dollars  
38 (\$70,000.00) or as much thereof as may be necessary.... 70,000.00

39 2. Of the moneys appropriated under paragraph 1,  
40 the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) or as  
41 much thereof as may be necessary, shall be used during  
42 each year of the biennium for research, pilot plant de-  
43 velopment and other necessary studies and operations  
44 designed to increase the profitable utilization of the  
45 crops and products of Iowa agriculture, particularly in  
46 processing for industrial and farm use. Without exclud-  
47 ing other related and necessary research, it is speci-  
48 fically authorized that studies shall be made of improve-  
49 ments in the retting and processing of hemp and its by-  
50 products in order to discover the possibilities of develop-  
51 ing a permanent hemp industry in Iowa; the discovery,  
52 development and processing of new grains, such as waxy  
53 corn, having special industrial uses; the industrial utili-  
54 zation of farm crops through fermentation and chemical  
55 processes; the development of methods of separating the  
56 constituents of farm products into those most useful in  
57 industry and those most useful on the farm; and studies  
58 in the economics of the development of local plants for  
59 the processing of crops and products of agricultural  
60 areas immediately adjacent.

61 3. Of the moneys appropriated under paragraph 1,  
62 the sum of twenty thousand (\$20,000.00), or as much  
63 thereof as may be necessary, shall be used in each year  
64 of the biennium for increasing and improving the facili-  
65 ties, buildings, equipment and personnel, and for provid-  
66 ing for the necessary costs of conducting additional  
67 studies and research on the development of farm crops  
68 better adapted to agriculture in the State of Iowa and  
69 for their increase and distribution. It is specifically di-

70 rected that during the period of the war emergency em-  
 71 phasis should be laid upon the development and distribu-  
 72 tion of better strains of hybrid corn with emphasis upon  
 73 resistance to the European corn borer, upon the breeding  
 74 of better soybeans and grains, and upon the development  
 75 of types or varieties which may be of special value be-  
 76 cause of their adaptability to industrial utilization.

77 4. Of the moneys appropriated under paragraph 1,  
 78 the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), or as  
 79 much thereof as may be necessary, shall be used for ad-  
 80 ditional studies and research on the feeding, nutrition  
 81 and management of livestock, particularly cattle, swine  
 82 and sheep. These moneys may be used for all necessary  
 83 facilities, buildings, equipment and personnel, and for  
 84 providing for the necessary costs of operation.

85 5. Of the moneys appropriated under paragraph 1,  
 86 the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), or as  
 87 much thereof as may be necessary, shall be used for  
 88 studying the more profitable utilization of the muck,  
 89 peat, eroded and sand lands of Iowa. Without excluding  
 90 other pertinent and relevant research, it is directed  
 91 that special emphasis be placed upon the utilization of  
 92 these lands for the commercial production of vegetable  
 93 crops; upon the control of diseases and pests by breed-  
 94 ing, crop rotation and direct treatment; upon the de-  
 95 velopment of better quality and higher yields by appro-  
 96 priate soil fertilization, drainage, irrigation, prevention  
 97 of erosion; upon the control of drainage ditch sedimenta-  
 98 tion; and upon the development of better facilities and  
 99 methods of marketing.

### (3) IOWA STATE TEACHERS COLLEGE CEDAR FALLS

102 For the Iowa State Teachers College there is hereby appropriated  
 103 from the general fund of the state for each year of the biennium be-  
 104 ginning July 1, 1943, and ending June 30, 1945, the sum of seven  
 105 hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$725,000.00), or so much  
 106 thereof as may be necessary to be used in the following manner:

107	(a) For salaries, support and maintenance.....	\$ 685,000.00
108	(b) For repairs, replacements or alterations.....	10,000.00
109	(c) For salary and wage increases to employees re- 110 ceiving less than \$2000 annually, but in no case 111 shall any salary affected under this item be in- 112 creased to exceed \$2000.....	30,000.00

116	ning July 1, 1943, and ending June 30, 1945, the sum of two hundred	
117	fifty-nine thousand one hundred dollars (\$259,100.00), or so much	
118	thereof as may be necessary to be used in the following manner:	
119	(a) For salaries, support and maintenance.....	\$ 240,000.00
120	(b) For repairs, replacements or alterations.....	2,100.00
121	(c) For salary and wage increases to employees re-	
122	ceiving less than \$2000 annually, but in no case

130	may be necessary to be used in the following manner:	
131	(a) For salaries, support and maintenance.....	\$ 135,000.00
132	(b) For repairs, replacements or alterations.....	3,000.00
133	(c) For salary and wage increases to employees re-	
134	ceiving less than \$2000 annually, but in no case	
135	shall any salary affected under this item be in-	
136	creased to exceed \$2000.....	5,000.00

142	sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as	
143	may be necessary to be used in the manner and under the authority	
144	provided in said chapter.	
145	For salary and wage increases to employees receiving less than	
146	\$2000 annually, but in no case shall any salary affected under this	
147	item be increased to exceed \$2000, the sum of one hundred thousand	
148	dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary.

## (7)—PSYCHOPATHIC HOSPITAL

151 For the psychopathic hospital at Iowa City, Iowa, there is hereby  
 152 appropriated from the general fund of the state for each year of the  
 153 biennium beginning July 1, 1943, and ending June 30, 1945, the sum  
 154 of one hundred eight thousand dollars (\$108,000.00) or so much  
 155 thereof as may be necessary to be expended in the manner and under  
 156 the authority provided in chapter one hundred seventy-three and one-  
 157 tenth (173.1), Code, 1939, provided however that the amounts shall  
 158 be available in monthly installments not exceeding nine thousand  
 159 seven hundred dollars (\$9,700.00) and that said installments shall be  
 160 expended only upon submission of bills in the manner provided in  
 161 section thirty-four hundred eighty-two and twenty-eight hundredths  
 162 (3482.28) of said chapter.

163 For salary and wage increases to employees receiving less than  
 164 \$2000 annually, but in no case shall any salary affected under this  
 165 item be increased to exceed \$2000, the sum of eight thousand dollars  
 166 (\$8,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary.

(8) BACTERIOLOGICAL AND HYGIENIC LABORATORY  
STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

168 For the bacteriological and hygienic laboratory of the department  
 169 of health there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the  
 170 state for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1943, and end-  
 171 ing June 30, 1945, the sum of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000.00)  
 172 or so much thereof as may be necessary to provide for public health  
 173 examination such as bacteriological, water and serological tests to  
 174 determine the cause of infectious diseases, the origin and control of  
 175 epidemics throughout the state of Iowa.

176 For salary and wage increases to employees receiving less than  
 177 \$2000 annually, but in no case shall any salary affected under this  
 178 item be increased to exceed \$2000, the sum of twenty-seven hundred  
 179 dollars (\$2,700.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary.

 181 State Department of Health.....\$ 82,700.00

182 Grand total for all purposes to the board of education  
 183 for all institutions under said board of education.....\$7,648,300.00
