CHAPTER 92
DISTURBING ANIMAL DENS

H. F. 50

AN ACT to amend section one thousand seven hundred ninety-four and fifty-two thousandths (1794.052), code, 1939, relating to the state game laws.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section one thousand seven hundred ninety-four and
 2 fifty-two thousandths (1794.052), Code, 1939, is hereby amended as
 3 follows:

4 1. Strike the words "in the" in line number four (4) and the word
 5 "presence" in line number five (5) and substitute therefor the words
 6 "by permission".

1 SEC. 2. Amend section one thousand seven hundred ninety-four
 2 and fifty-two thousandths (1794.052), Code, 1939, by adding to said
 3 section the following: "Provided however, that nothing in this sec-
 4 tion shall prohibit the owner thereof to destroy any such den to pro-
 5 tect his own property."

CHAPTER 93
FISH AND GAME CONSERVATION

AN ACT to repeal section seventeen hundred ninety-four and fifty-seven thousandths (1794.057), code, 1939, relating to agents of licensed fur dealers.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section seventeen hundred ninety-four and fifty-seven
 2 thousandths (1794.057), Code, 1939, is hereby repealed.
