## CHAPTER 287

## MONONA COUNTY FARMERS AND GARRETSON DRAINAGE DISTRICT H. F. 135

AN ACT to legalize proceedings of the board of supervisors of Monona county, Iowa, for account of Farmers and Garretson drainage district in said county with respect to the levy of assessments to pay the cost of improvements in and for said drainage district and with respect to the issuance of bonds for account of said drainage district in anticipation of the collection of the unpaid portion of said assessments.

Wheras, the board of supervisors of Monona County, Iowa, for and on account of Farmers and Garretson Drainage District in said county, did heretofore on October 20, 1938, and December 21, 1942, pursuant to published notices and hearings, levy and confirm assessments upon the several lots and tracts of land in said drainage district to pay the cost of improvements in and for said drainage district and on December 21, 1942, by resolution, did order and provide for the issuance of bonds to the amount of twenty-eight thousand dollars in anticipation of the collection of the unpaid portion of said assessments; and

Whereas, doubts have arisen concerning the legality or validity of said proceedings and bonds, and it is deemed advisable to put said doubts as well as any and all others at rest;

Now, Therefore, Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. All proceedings of the board of supervisors of Monona County, Iowa, with respect to the levy and confirmation of assessments upon the several lots and tracts of land in Farmers and Garretson Drainage District in said county, and with respect to the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection of the unpaid portion of said assessments, he and the same are hereby legalized and validated, and
- 6 assessments, be and the same are hereby legalized and validated, and 7 that drainage bonds in the principal amount of twenty-eight thousand
- 8 dollars dated January 1, 1943, issued pursuant to said proceedings 9 are hereby legalized and validated.
- 1 SEC 2. Nothing in this act shall affect pending litigation.
- SEC 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Onawa Sentinel, a newspaper published in Onawa, Iowa, and in the Mapleton Press, a newspaper published in Mapleton, Iowa, all without expense to the state.
