EMPLOYEES OF BOARD OF CONTROL

S. F. 438

AN ACT to amend sections two hundred eighteen point six (218.6) and two hundred eighteen point nine (218.9), code 1946, relating to tenure of office of business managers, superintendents, wardens or other chief executive officers of board of control institutions.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section two hundred eighteen point six (218.6), Code 1 1946, is hereby amended by striking from lines twenty-one (21) and twenty-two (22) the words "for a term of four years" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "and shall hold office at the pleasure of the 2 3 4 board". 5

SEC. 2. Section two hundred eighteen point six (218.6), Code 1946, 1 2 is further amended by adding thereto the following: "The tenure of 3 office of business managers as herein provided shall be applicable to 4 present existing appointments.".

SEC. 3. Section two hundred eighteen point nine (218.9), Code 1946, 1 is hereby amended by striking from lines eight (8) and nine (9) the words "four years from the date of appointment" and inserting in lieu 2 3 thereof the words "at the pleasure of the board". 4

SEC. 4. Section two hundred eighteen point nine (218.9), Code 1946. is further amended by adding thereto the following: "The tenure of 2 3 office of said officers as herein provided shall be applicable to present existing appointments". 4

2 (218.58), Code 1946, by striking the period following the word "year"

in line eleven (11) and adding in lieu thereof a comma (,) and the words "unless a larger amount is approved by the Committee on 3

4 Retrenchment and Reform." 5
