PRIMARY ROAD REVERSION

H. F. 132

AN ACT to amend section three hundred thirteen point two (313.2), code 1946, relating to reversion of highways no longer within the primary road system.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section three hundred thirteen point two (313.2), Code 1946, is hereby amended by striking from lines seventeen (17) and eighteen (18) the words "system from which originally taken" and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "secondary road system provided however that the state highway commission shall first allocate sufficient funds to put the road in good repair or assume 2 3 4 5 6 responsibility for all necessary repairs".

INTERSTATE BRIDGES

AN ACT to amend section three hundred thirteen point thirty-two (313.32), code 1946, relating to the acceptance by the highway commission of interstate bridges.
