fifteen to eighteen (15-18), inclusive, and inserting the following: "Each operator's license issued after July 5, 1948 shall expire two years from the licensee's birthday anniversary occurring in the year of issuance. For the purposes of this section the birthday anniversary of a person born on February 29 shall be deemed to occur on March 1.

## CHAPTER 142 BUS SPEED LIMITS H. F. 408

AN ACT to amend section three hundred twenty-one point two hundred eighty-seven (321.287), Code 1946, relating to the bus speed limits.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point two hundred eighty-seven (321.287), Code 1946, is hereby amended by striking all of lines five (5) and six (6) and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "fifty-five miles per hour during the day time or at a greater rate of speed than fifty miles per hour during the night time.\* "Night time" means from one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise, except at any other hour or any time when due to weather or other conditions there is not sufficient light to make persons and vehicles clearly discernible at a distance of more than five hundred feet. No school bus shall be operated in violation of section 321.377.

## CENTER LINES ON HIGHWAYS

S. F. 182

AN ACT to amend section three hundred twenty-one point three hundred four (321.304), Code 1946, relating to motor vehicles and law of road.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Subsection three (3) of section three hundred twenty-
- one point three hundred four (321.304), Code 1946, is hereby amended by adding after the word "line" where it first appears in line three (3) thereof the following: "or off-center line".
