 2 there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for

 4 30, 1955, the sum of one hundred ten thousand nine hundred ten dol-
 5 lars (\$110,910.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used
 6 in the following manner:

10	For vocational training and equipment.....	2,500.00

CHAPTER 3

FIRE DAMAGE AT STATE INSTITUTIONS

H. F. 456

AN ACT to appropriate funds to the board of control for the repair to buildings and for the restoration and replacement of furniture, fixtures, equipment and other items of institutional property damaged by fire in the auditorium at the state penitentiary at Fort Madison on January 12, 1953, and in the laundry building at the Cherokee mental health institute on February 9, 1953.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state to the board of control the sum of sixty-eight thousand dol-
 3 lars (\$68,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used
 4 for the following purposes:

5 (a) At the State Penitentiary, Fort Madison, Iowa, for restoring
 6 the auditorium building and restoring or replacing furniture, fixtures,
 7 furnishings, and equipment damaged or destroyed by fire January 12,
 8 1953,\$56,500.00.

9 (b) At the Cherokee Mental Health Institute, Cherokee, Iowa, for
 10 restoring the laundry building and restoring or replacing furniture,
 11 fixtures, furnishings, equipment and other items of institutional prop-
 12 erty, including bedding, linens and clothing damaged or destroyed by
 13 fire February 9, 1953,\$11,500.00.

1 SEC. 2. Any unexpended balance of the funds herein appropriated
 2 as of June 30, 1955, shall revert to the general fund of the state.

1 SEC. 3. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall be
 2 in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in

3 The Donnellson Review, a newspaper published at Donnellson, Iowa,
4 and the Cherokee Daily Times, a newspaper published at Cherokee,
5 Iowa.

CHAPTER 4

BOARD OF CONTROL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

H. F. 487

AN ACT to appropriate funds for certain capital improvements for institutions under the board of control including construction of new buildings, repairs, improvements, replacements or alterations, and providing for the joint control of the expenditure thereof by the board of control and the budget and financial control committee.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of
2 the state to the board of control the sum of three million seven hun-
3 dred thousand dollars (\$3,700,000.00) to be used in the following
4 manner to-wit:

5 To supplement any of the appropriations for capital improvement
6 items included in chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-first General
7 Assembly, in chapter twelve (12), Acts of the Fifty-second General
8 Assembly and in chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-third General
9 Assembly, or for any other capital expenditure the board of control
10 may deem necessary for the proper and necessary function of any
11 institution under its jurisdiction.

1 SEC. 2. Before any of the funds herein appropriated shall be ex-
2 pended it shall be determined by the state board of control with the
3 approval of the budget and financial control committee that the ex-
4 penditure shall be for the best interest of the state.

1 SEC. 3. When contracts, plans and specifications or plan of opera-
2 tion for an improvement for which funds are herein appropriated has
3 been accepted by the state board of control, and approved and certi-
4 fied by the budget and financial control committee, the state comp-
5 troller shall allocate the funds for each such improvement.

1 SEC. 4. The provisions of all acts or statutes in conflict or incon-
2 sistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

1 SEC. 5. The board of control and the budget and financial control
2 committee are hereby authorized to obtain federal grants to the state
3 to be used in connection with the funds above appropriated or di-
4 verted for such construction purpose.

1 SEC. 6. The governor and budget and financial control committee
2 are hereby directed to transfer from the special reserve fund created
3 by the provisions of chapter forty-four (44), Acts of the Fifty-third
