

3 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1953, and ending June 30,
 4 1955, the sum of twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000.00), or so much
 5 thereof as may be necessary, for general state aid to school districts
 6 as provided by chapter two hundred eighty-six A (286A), Code 1950,
 7 provided, however, that no school district shall receive financial aid
 8 under the provisions of said Code chapter in the event a school tax
 9 levy for the general fund of at least eight (8) mills was not made
 10 in such district for the preceding year.

CHAPTER 15

SCHOOL AID APPROPRIATIONS

H. F. 495

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the department of public instruction twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) for use as a revolving fund for the veterans administration, and seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00) for the school lunch program.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1953, and ending June
 3 30, 1955, to the department of public instruction the sum of twenty
 4 thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) or so much thereof as may be neces-
 5 sary for the use of the veterans education program to be used as a
 6 revolving fund to pay, salaries and travel of personnel which will be
 7 reimbursed by the veterans administration.

8 Total\$20,000.00

1 SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the
 2 state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1953, and ending June 30,
 3 1955, to the department of public instruction the sum of seven thou-
 4 sand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00) or so much thereof as may be
 5 necessary to be used as a revolving fund to cover warehousing, han-
 6 dling, and transportation of direct distribution of federal surplus
 7 commodities which will be reimbursed by charging pro rata costs of
 8 these items to receiving schools and institutions.

CHAPTER 16

CONSERVATION COMMISSION APPROPRIATION

S. F. 452

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the state conservation commission for emergency work and certain other construction work.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated and set out of the gen-
 2 eral fund of the state from any moneys not otherwise appropriated,

3 to the state conservation commission the sum of eight hundred forty-
 4 three thousand dollars (\$843,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
 5 necessary for the treatment of waters or emergency work to maintain
 6 state owned lakes and waters but said funds appropriated and set
 7 aside by this Act shall not be expended until it shall be determined by
 8 the conservation commission with approval of the budget and financial
 9 control committee that its expenditures shall be for the best interests
 10 of the state.

1 SEC. 2. The treasurer of the state of Iowa is hereby empowered
 2 to invest any of the funds so appropriated and set aside by the pro-
 3 visions of section one (1) of this Act in securities of the United States
 4 Government.

1 SEC. 3. When contracts, plans and specifications for improvements
 2 for which funds are herein appropriated have been accepted by the
 3 conservation commission, and approved and certified by the budget
 4 and financial control committee of the state of Iowa, the state treas-
 5 urer is authorized and directed to sell sufficient securities herein pro-
 6 vided in section two (2) of this Act to cover the cost of said improve-
 7 ment.

1 SEC. 4. The state conservation commission is hereby authorized
 2 and directed to expend for systematic treatment of the waters of Storm
 3 Lake, Buena Vista County, Iowa with copper sulphate or other chem-
 4 ical during the years 1953 and 1954 for treatment of blue-green algae
 5 the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary from the sum appropriated in section 1
 7 hereof.

CHAPTER 17

CONSERVATION COMMISSION CLAIMS APPROPRIATIONS

S. F. 437

AN ACT to direct and authorize payment to certain persons in settlement of claims arising out of administration of the conservation commission.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. It is hereby directed and authorized that payment be
 2 made out of the administration fund provided by section one hundred
 3 seven point seventeen (107.17), subsection three (3), Code 1950,
 4 of the conservation commission of the state of Iowa to the following
 5 named persons the amounts set opposite their respective names, in
 6 full settlement of all claims which they may have against the state
 7 of Iowa on arising out of administration of the state conservation
 8 commission:
