

3 to the state conservation commission the sum of eight hundred forty-
 4 three thousand dollars (\$843,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
 5 necessary for the treatment of waters or emergency work to maintain
 6 state owned lakes and waters but said funds appropriated and set
 7 aside by this Act shall not be expended until it shall be determined by
 8 the conservation commission with approval of the budget and financial
 9 control committee that its expenditures shall be for the best interests
 10 of the state.

1 SEC. 2. The treasurer of the state of Iowa is hereby empowered
 2 to invest any of the funds so appropriated and set aside by the pro-
 3 visions of section one (1) of this Act in securities of the United States
 4 Government.

1 SEC. 3. When contracts, plans and specifications for improvements
 2 for which funds are herein appropriated have been accepted by the
 3 conservation commission, and approved and certified by the budget
 4 and financial control committee of the state of Iowa, the state treas-
 5 urer is authorized and directed to sell sufficient securities herein pro-
 6 vided in section two (2) of this Act to cover the cost of said improve-
 7 ment.

1 SEC. 4. The state conservation commission is hereby authorized
 2 and directed to expend for systematic treatment of the waters of Storm
 3 Lake, Buena Vista County, Iowa with copper sulphate or other chem-
 4 ical during the years 1953 and 1954 for treatment of blue-green algae
 5 the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary from the sum appropriated in section 1
 7 hereof.

CHAPTER 17

CONSERVATION COMMISSION CLAIMS APPROPRIATIONS

S. F. 437

AN ACT to direct and authorize payment to certain persons in settlement of claims arising out of administration of the conservation commission.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. It is hereby directed and authorized that payment be
 2 made out of the administration fund provided by section one hundred
 3 seven point seventeen (107.17), subsection three (3), Code 1950,
 4 of the conservation commission of the state of Iowa to the following
 5 named persons the amounts set opposite their respective names, in
 6 full settlement of all claims which they may have against the state
 7 of Iowa on arising out of administration of the state conservation
 8 commission:

1 SEC. 2. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to issue his
 2 warrants to the above named parties in the amounts stated. The
 3 acceptance of such sums of the above named parties shall be in full
 4 settlement of all claims against the state of Iowa growing out of the
 5 above described claims. The state treasurer is directed to pay the
 6 same from the designated fund.

CHAPTER 18

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY RADIO APPROPRIATION

H. F. 434

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the department of public safety for the purpose of various capital improvements for the division of radio communication.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the division of radio
 2 communication, department of public safety, from the general fund
 3 of the state the sum of ninety one thousand three hundred dollars
 4 (\$91,300.00) to be used for two radio buildings, moving and replacing
 5 two radio towers, four repeater housing units, building, equipment
 6 and tower for new base station, moving one repeater, moving two
 7 radio stations and for additional repeaters, towers and associated
 8 equipment.

1 SEC. 2. Before any of the fund herein appropriated shall be ex-
 2 pended it shall be determined by the department of public safety, with
 3 the approval of the executive council, that the expenditure shall be
 4 for the best interests of the state.

1 SEC. 3. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in
 2 full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as
 3 provided by law, in the Davis County Republican, a newspaper pub-
 4 lished at Bloomfield, Iowa, and in the Fort Madison Evening Demo-
 5 crat, a newspaper published at Fort Madison, Iowa.
