SEC. 2. Before any of the funds herein appropriated shall be expended, it shall be determined by the national guard and state guard, 1

with the approval of the executive council, that the expenditure shall be for the best interests of the state.

AN ACT to appropriate funds to the state comptroller from the motor vehicle fuel tax fund.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:
