## CHAPTER 98

## BANG'S DISEASE

S. F. 65

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred sixty-four (164), Code 1954, relating to Bang's disease.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section one hundred sixty-four point seventeen 2 (164.17), Code 1954, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

"Whenever petitions signed by seventy-five percent of the resident 4 5 owners of breeding cattle residing in a county representing seventyfive percent or more of the breeding cattle therein owned by residents of that area, as disclosed by the last assessment rolls of such area, 8 shall be presented to the department asking that all breeding cattle herds in said county be tested for brucellosis, the department is hereby authorized to make such tests without expense to the owners, to the 10 extent of the funds available therefor. Each of the petitions shall be 11 upon forms prepared by the department which forms shall include a 12 space for a statement of the number of breeding cattle owned by each 13 signer. The circulator thereof shall make a statement under oath on 14 each petition that he is the person who circulated the petition, that 15
