and pertaining thereto, and all acts of such body and officers shall be as valid and binding as if performed within the territorial limits of their political subdivision.

SEC. 3. The provisions of this Act shall control and be supreme in the event it shall be employed notwithstanding any statutory, charter or ordinance provision to the contrary or in conflict herewith.

## CHAPTER 92

## TERMS OF COUNTY OFFICERS

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\text { H. F. } 702
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AN ACT relating to the terms of county officers.
Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section thirty-nine point seventeen (39.17), Code 1958, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:
"There shall be elected in each county at the general election to be held in the year 1960 and every four (4) years thereafter, a clerk of the district court, an auditor and a sheriff who shall hold office for a term of four (4) years.
"There shall be elected in each county at the general election to be held in the year 1960 a treasurer, and a recorder of deeds who shall hold office for a term of two (2) years and at the general election to be held in 1962 and each four (4) years thereafter, such officers shall be elected and hold office for a term of four (4) years.
"There shall be elected in each county, at each general election, a county attorney, who shall hold office for a term of two (2) years."

## CHAPTER 93

OFFICIAL BALLOT
S. F. 268

AN ACT relating to publication of the official ballot.
Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

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SECTION 1. Section forty-nine point fifty-four (49.54), Code 1958, is hereby repealed and the following is enacted in lieu thereof:
"For publication of the official ballot, the cost shall not exceed seventy (70) dollars for each of the two (2) papers in which it shall be published."
