## CHAPTER 123

### CONSERVATION OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

H. F. 173

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred seven (107), Code 1958, relating to fidelity bonds for conservation commission officers and employees.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one hundred seven point seven (107.7), Code  
2 1958, is hereby amended by striking from lines one (1), two (2),  
3 three (3) the words "The commission may require bonds of appoint-  
4 ees and employees other than those herein specifically named." and  
5 inserting in lieu thereof the following: "The conservation commis-  
6 sion may obtain an adequate public employees honesty blanket posi-  
7 tion bond covering all or part of the officers or employees accountable  
8 for property or funds of the state of Iowa in which case the officers  
9 or employees so covered shall not be required to furnish individual  
10 bonds."

1 SEC. 2. Section one hundred seven point eight (107.8), Code 1958,  
2 is hereby amended by striking from line one (1) the word "all", and  
3 in line two (2) the letter "s" from the word "bonds".

## CHAPTER 124

### CONSERVATION OFFICERS

S. F. 287

AN ACT to amend section one hundred seven point thirteen (107.13), Code 1958, relating to salaries of conservation officers.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one hundred seven point thirteen (107.13),  
2 Code 1958, is amended by striking all of the section after the word  
3 "be" in line fifteen (15) and inserting in lieu thereof the following,  
4 "thirty-seven hundred eighty dollars (\$3,780.00) per year for the  
5 first year of service. A salary increase of fifteen dollars per month  
6 shall be granted to each officer at the end of the first year and every  
7 six months thereafter until an annual salary rate of forty-six hun-  
8 dred eighty dollars (\$4,680.00) is reached. Thereafter conservation  
9 officers shall be paid additional compensation in accordance with the  
10 following formula: When conservation officers have served for a
