Section one hundred seven point seven (107.7), Code 1958, is hereby amended by striking from lines one (1), two (2), three (3) the words "The commission may require bonds of appoint-ees and employees other than those herein specifically named." and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "The conservation commission may obtain an adequate public employees honesty blanket position bond covering all or part of the officers or employees accountable for property or funds of the state of Iowa in which case the officers or employees so covered shall not be required to furnish individual bonds."
- SEC. 2. Section one hundred seven point eight (107.8), Code 1958, is hereby amended by striking from line one (1) the word "all", and in line two (2) the letter "s" from the word "bonds".
