TAKING TURTLES AND CRAYFISH

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred nine (109), Code 1958, to make it illegal for nonresidents to take turtles or crayfish in Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

CHAPTER 129

HUNTING, FISHING AND TRAPPING LICENSE EXEMPTIONS

AN ACT relating to exemption of inmates of county homes from securing a license to hunt, fish or trap on land or in the waters of the state.

CHAPTER 130

HUNTING LICENSES

H. F. 344

AN ACT relating to hunting license for children under sixteen (16) years of age.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section one hundred ten point seventeen (110.17), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

"No resident of the state under sixteen (16) years of age shall be required to have a license to hunt game if accompanied by his or her parent or guardian or in company with any other competent adult with the consent of the said parent or guardian, if the said person accompanying said minor shall possess a valid hunting license."
