CHAPTER 159

GIFTS TO BOARD OF CONTROL

H. F. 660

AN ACT to authorize the board of control to accept and use gifts, grants, devises or bequests of real or personal property.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred eighteen (218), Code 1958, is

2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

"The board of control is authorized to accept gifts, grants, devises or bequests of real or personal property from the federal government or any source. The board may exercise such powers with reference to the property so accepted as may be deemed essential to its preservation and the purposes for which given, devised or bequeathed."

CHAPTER 160*

BOARD OF CONTROL REAL ESTATE

S. F. 430

AN ACT relating to the acquiring and sale of real estate by the board of control.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred eighteen (218), Code 1958, is

hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

"The board of control shall have full power, subject to the approval of the budget and financial control committee to acquire and sell real estate for the proper uses of said institutions. Real estate shall be acquired and sold upon such terms and conditions as the board may recommend subject to the approval of the budget and financial control 8 committee. Upon sale of such real estate, the proceeds thereof shall be deposited with the treasurer of state and credited to the general fund of the state. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state a sum equal to the proceeds so deposited and credited to 11 12 the general fund of the state to the state board of control, which with 13 the prior approval of the budget and financial control committee, may 14 be used to purchase other real estate or for capital improvements upon

b property under its control."
