CHAPTER 294

SPECIAL CHARTER CITIES

S. F. 273

AN ACT to amend section four hundred twenty point forty-one (420.41), Code 1958, relating to general powers and provisions of cities under special charter.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section four hundred twenty point forty-one (420.41), Code 1958, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of such section the following subsections:

"Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection one (1) of this section, the fiscal year for special charter cities, which prior to and concurrently with the taking effect of this Act collect general city taxes directly through their own officers, and for all departments, boards and commissions thereof, shall be as established by city ordinance.

8 9 "Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection one (1) of this section, special charter cities which prior to and concurrently with the 10 taking effect of this Act collect general city taxes directly through their own officers, shall, within the applicable provisions of chapter four hundred and four (404), make the appropriations for the necessary expenditures for the next ensuing fiscal year by ordinance. The proposed ordinance shall, upon first reading, be placed on file with the 11 12 13 14 15 clerk for public inspection, and, upon second reading, if and as amended, forthwith be published in a newspaper of general circulation, to-16 17 gether with the time and place for a public hearing on said proposed ordinance, which hearing shall be not less than ten (10) days prior 18 19 to the council meeting at which it shall be placed upon its passage." 20

SEC. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in The Daily Times, a newspaper published at Davenport, Iowa, and The Burlington Hawk-Eye Gazette, a newspaper published at Burlington, Iowa.
