of this chapter, shall be liable to the drainage or levee district with pumping stations maintaining said levee, for all damage sustained by 6 the drainage or levee district resulting from the violation, and in the event of flood, or other emergency so declared by resolution of the governing body any building or other structure, or ditch so constructed 8 without permission of the governing board, as required herein, and within three hundred (300) feet of the center line of any levee, may 9 10 be removed, or the ditch filled in, without prior notice thereof to the 11 12 owner.

CHAPTER 313

DRAINAGE TO HIGHWAY

S. F. 52

AN ACT relating to drainage that runs to a public highway.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section four hundred sixty-five point twenty-three 2 (465.23), Code 1958, is hereby amended as follows:
- 1. By inserting in line fifteen (15) of such section after the word, "line" the words, "or drainage ditch". 3

- 2. By striking from line eighteen (18) of such section the word, 5 "drain" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words, "line or drainage ditch".

CHAPTER 314

SOIL CONSERVATION SUBDISTRICTS

H. F. 452

AN ACT to provide for the powers and duties of subdistricts of soil conservation districts.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Chapter four hundred sixty-seven A (467A), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section:
- "A subdistrict organized under the provisions of this chapter shall have all of the powers of a soil conservation district in addition to
- other powers granted to the subdistrict in other sections of this chap-5
